# When words fail

One loves someone so much – a child, a parent, a spouse or partner - yet when one tries to pray for that person the words seem only a pale shadow of the intensity of feeling and total love one feels. We could pause for a moment to relax and to allow the Spirit to express our plea in a way which could never be put into words.
